ABA is the national body representing bowhunters and its sporting arm, Field Archery Australia is recognised as the body responsible for the development of the sport of field archery. ABA regulates bowhunting & sporting activities by members through a uniform Code of Ethics, Rules of Fair Chase, a National Bowhunter Education Programme & Club Accreditation programmes. Clubs must meet these requirements in terms of standards of organisation, operation & facilities, which enables members to be covered under the ABA Public Liability Insurance Policy. ABA affiliation requires Renegade Bowmen Inc to maintain its Incorporation under the Incorporation Act as part of ongoing accreditation otherwise penalties may apply.
